PAC

- PACHI-PACHI パチパチ adv. (coll.) Sharp crack-
ing noise, snapping: *hi ga — to haneru.*
- PAN パン 麵包 n. Bread, (this word is derived
from the Italian, or Portuguese, and is the
Latin word *panis*): — *yaki*, a baker; *panya*,
id.
- PANDANE パンデ子 n. Leaven, yeast.
- PANYA パンヤ n. A species of *Asclepias*, or
milk-weed, also the silky material obtained
from it.
- PAPPA パツパ — *to*, adv. Rising in a cloud,—
like dust: *chiri ga — to tatsu*, the dust rises;
kane wo — to tsukau, to spend money lavishly.
- PAPPU パツプ n. A poultice.
- PARA-PARA TO パラパラト adv. (coll.) The sound,
or manner of rain, hail, or tears falling in big
and scattered drops: *arare ga — furu.*
- PARARI TO パラリト adv. (coll.) In a scattered,
dispersed, or sprinkled manner: *hōsō ga —
dekita*, the small-pox pustules are distinct (not
confluent); *hoshi ga — deta.*
- PATA-PATA パタパタ adv. (coll.) The sound of
repeated slaps, flaps, or clapping: *niwatori ga
— to habataki wo suru.*
- PATCHI パッチ n. Trowsers, pantaloons made
of silk—such as are worn by the upper classes:
— *wo haku*, to wear breeches.
- PATCHIRI パッチリ adv. (coll.) The sharp,
sudden sound of anything cracking, snapping,
splitting, as of splitting a bamboo, bursting
the air-bladder of a fish, etc.
- PATCHIRI パッチリ 唐土 n. Native carbonate
of lead used as a cosmetic.
Syn. TŌNOTSUCHI.
- PATCHI-PATCHI パッチパッチ adv. (coll.) Sound-
ing in a sudden, sharp manner; clapping,
snapping, cracking, popping.
- PATTARI パツタリ adv. (coll.) The sound made
by anything falling, slapping, slamming: —
to taoreru, to fall with a bang.
- PATTE パツテ (Eng.) n. Putty.
- PATTO パツト adv. (coll.) In the manner of any-
thing suddenly bursting out, spreading: *hyō-
ban ga — hirogatta*, the report suddenly spread.
- PEIJI ペイジ (Eng.) n. Page,—of a book.
- PEN ペン (Eng.) n. A pen: *kimpen*, a gold pen;
pen-saki, point of a pen.
- PENKI ペンキ (Eng.) n. Paint.
- PENSHIRU ペンシル Eng. n. A lead-pencil=
empitsu.
- PENSU ペンス 片 (Eng.) Pence, =2.033 sen.
- PERA-PERA ペラペラ adv. (coll.) Quickly, fast:
— *to moyuru*; — *to shaberu.*

- PETENSHI ペテンシ n. (coll.) A cheat.
- PICHA-PICHA ピチャピチャ adv. The sound of
slapping: — *naguru*, to slap.
- PICHINDOME ピチンドメ n. (coll.) A cord used
for tightening a woman's belt or sash.
- PICHI-PICHI ピチピチ adv. Alive and flapping
its tail,—as a live fish on the ground.
- PIKA-PIKA ピカピカ adv. — *suru*, to glitter.
- PIN ピン (Eng.) n. A pin.
- PIN ピン n. The ace on a dice.
- PINPIN ピンピン adv. Strong, well, robust,
lively: *ano hito tassha de — shite iru*, he is
well and lively; *uma ga — haneru*, the horse
is lively.
- PIRI-PIRI ピリピリ adv. (coll.) In a pricking,
burning, or smarting manner,—as the taste
of pepper.
- PISSHARI ピツシヤリ adv. (coll.) Like the
sound of the crushing of egg-shells, shutting a
screen, slamming a door, banging: *to wo —
to shimeru*, to slam the door.
- PIYOI TO ピヨイト adv. (coll.) Hopping like a
frog, bird, etc.; skipping: *kogawa wo — tobi-
kosu*, to hop or skip across a narrow rivulet.
- PIYOKO-PIYOKO TO ピヨコピヨコト adv. (coll.)
Same as *hiyoko-hiyoko.*
- POCHA-POCHA ポチャポチャ Round and fat,—as
the face: *ano onna no kao — shite iru.*
- POKAN ポカン adv. (coll.) In a vacant, thought-
less or absent manner: — *to shite iru.*
- POKA-POKA ポカポカ adv. Sound of frequent
slapping; also warm: *atama wo — butsu*, to
slap the head often; *kyō wa — suru hi da*,
this is a warm day.
- POKATSUKI, -KU ポカツク i.v. To be warm,
pleasant.
- POKI-POKI ポキポキ adv. (coll.) The sound of
cracking: *yubi wo — oru*, to crack the fingers.
- POKU-POKU ポクポク adv. (coll.) Like the
sound of striking pieces of wood together:
mokugyo wo — to tataku.
- POMPU ポンプ (Eng.) n. Pump.
- PŌNDO パウンド 封 (Eng.) n. Pound, =av.
120.748 momme. Troy, 99.3583 momme.
- PON-PON ポンポン n. The belly (child. lang.):
— *ga itaku natta*, I have the belly-ache.
- PON-PON ポンポン adv. (coll.) The sound of
successive reports, as of guns: *teppō wo — to
hanasu.*
- POPPO ポツポ n. (coll.) The bosom of the dress
(used by children): *te wo — ye ireru.*
- POPPO TO ポツポト adv. (coll.) Hot, heated
appearance: — *atsui.*
